## HOW NCC HELPS

### DEFENCE SERVICES

- Vacancies reserved for commission in the Defence Forces for NCC "C" Certificate Holders:
  - i) Army - IMA Dehradun. 32 vacancies per course through UPSC and SSB interview.
    - OTA Chennai. 50 vacancies per course for Short Service Commission (Non Tech). No UPSC exam, only SSB interview.
  - ii) Navy - 6 vacancies per course. No UPSC exam, only SSB Interview. Two years age relaxation for NCC "C" Certificate holders.
  - iii) Air Force - 10% in all courses including flying training courses. No UPSC exam, only SSB.

- For OR, Sailors, Airmen: 5 to 10% bonus marks for recruitment.
- 20% reservation for Girl Cadets in OTA, Chennai

### OTHER SERVICES

- Para Military Forces-2 to 10 bonus marks for recruitment.
- Department of Telecommunications Bonus marks awarded for recruitment.
- NCC-Civilian Gliding Instructors/Girl Cadet Instructors/Whole Time Lady Officers.
- State Governments-Preference for State Services in certain states. Private Sector-Many industries give preference to NCC "C" certificate holders for recruitments.
- Sports-Cash awards to teams and individuals for excellence.
- Scholarships-NCC cadets eligible for scholarship ranging from Rs. 6,000/- to Rs. 30,000/-through Cadet Welfare Society and Sahara Scholarships.
- Risk Coverage-NCC activities.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PROPOSAL

- UGC has approached Universities for offering NCC as a General Elective Subject Course in their undergraduate courses.
- Proposed syllabus has been designed on the recommendations received from the Directorate General of NCC.
- Course structured with 24 credits for 6 semesters, spanning 3 years.
- 24 credits allocated as 4 credits in the first two semesters, 10 credits in the third and fourth semesters and 10 credits in the fifth and sixth semesters.
- Proposal has been inspired by the new National Education Policy (NEP 2020) and is based on 'Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)
- Many states are now offering NCC as a subject for academic study.
