**Standard Operating Procedures for NAI
effective with opening of offline classes**

As per letter of UP State Government dated 4th August, 2021 reference No. 1786/17 – 3 – 2021 – 8 (20) 2020 we are scheduling to start offline classes for all PG and UG programme.

However, standard COVID protocol have to be observed including COVID appropriate behaviour like wearing mask and maintaining social distancing.

Following SoP's are essential to be observed.

1. All faculty and students need to have proof of 1st and 2nd dose of vaccination at the time of registration. Digital certificate must be carried on person at all times.
2. Downloading of Arogya Setu App is mandatory.
3. Hand-sanitizer have been provided at all entry & exit points. They must be used appropriately.
4. Classrooms, corridors, washrooms to be sanitized daily.
5. All PG students including Ph.D. must report for offline classes by 30th August, 2021 and will need to have above mentioned documents. Freshly admitted PG students will have to register with all required document (information available on website).
6. Students of UG 5th Semester B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B. Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture and B. Sc. (Hons.) Animal Husbandry will report for offline classes from 6th September, 2021. Apart from vaccination certificate, they need to produce current fee receipt.


7. Students of 3rd semester B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B. Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture and B. Sc. (Hons.) Animal Husbandry will report for offline classes from 14th September, 2021. Online classes will continue till then.
8. Students of 1st semester of three UG programmes i.e. B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, B. Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture and B. Sc. (Hons.) Animal Husbandry will report for offline classes from 21st September, 2021. They will report to Dean's office, Naini Agricultural Institute with all necessary original documents required for registration.
9. Students coming from towns of North East, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala and Maharashtra will need to have a fresh RTPCR report not older than 72 hrs.
10. The student who plan to avail Hostel facilities must register on University Hostel portal (Chief Warden). All details are available on website.

This notification may change accordingly subject to guidelines issued by Government of Uttar Pradesh.

We hope the students will enjoy this God gifted campus and Institution.
